Subject: 2019 Olympiad on knowledge of Natural and Technological Hazards

Dear Sir/Madam,

I wish to inform you about an Olympiad on knowledge of Natural and Technological Hazards to be organised in April 2019 under the auspices of the European and Mediterranean Major Hazards Agreement (EUR-OPA) of the Council of Europe, in collaboration with the Cyprus Civil Defence. The EUR-OPA Agreement is a platform for cooperation between 26 countries in Europe and South of the Mediterranean in the field of disaster prevention and preparedness since 1987.

Natural hazards and technological accidents cause a great number of casualties and important economic losses every year. Although it may not be possible to prevent certain hazards, we aim to reduce vulnerability to disasters by providing, in particular to teachers and school students, accurate information on risks and how to mitigate the consequences.

Organised in the framework of the BeSafeNet project, the purpose of this Olympiad is to foster knowledge on hazards and the associated preventive measures among secondary school students. It consists of an online competition (in English) based on the BeSafenet.net tool (a website providing reliable educational material about hazards and preparedness) open to all secondary schools (16 years old maximum) in the 26 member States of the Agreement<sup>1</sup>.
